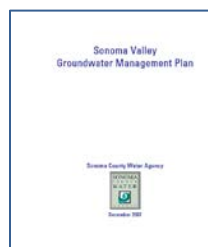


Groundwater Management Plan Goal Statements



Santa Clara Valley Water District

- *Groundwater supplies are managed to optimize water supply reliability and minimize land subsidence.*
- *Groundwater is protected from existing and potential contamination, including salt water intrusion.*



Sonoma Valley GWMP

The goal of the Plan is to locally manage, protect, and enhance groundwater resources for all beneficial uses, in a sustainable, environmentally sound, economical, and equitable manner for generations to come.



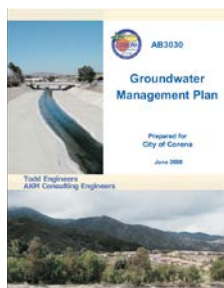
South East Bay Plain

The overarching goal of the South East Bay Plain Basin GMP is to preserve the local groundwater basin as a reliable and sustainable water supply for current and future beneficial uses.



South Westside Basin

The goal of the GWMP is to ensure a sustainable, high quality, reliable water supply at a fair price for beneficial uses achieved through local groundwater management.



City of Corona

The Goals of the GWMP include:

- *Operate the groundwater basin in a sustainable manner for beneficial uses*
- *Increase the reliability of water supply for basin users*

1. Provide basin users with a long-term, reliable and affordable high-quality groundwater supply
2. Maintain the rights and beneficial uses of groundwater users within the basin
3. Maintain local control over groundwater to the fullest extent possible
4. Promote public participation and involvement in local groundwater management efforts
5. Develop an effective dispute resolution mechanism
6. Develop funding mechanisms for the groundwater management plan
