How to Resolve Common Parking Issues

If you have concerns about parking issues, including cars parked across a driveway, inoperable and or abandoned vehicles, and vehicles parked more than 72 hours please read this quick guide on how to resolve your issue.



Parking enforcement is handled through the Police Department. Depending on the issue, there are several ways to contact the Police Department regarding a parking matter.

First, if somebody is blocking your driveway, call Police Dispatch at (650) 321-1112.

Second, to report an inoperable vehicle, or abandoned vehicle, or vehicles parked more than 72 hours without moving, call (650) 853-5940.

- Color
- Year
- Make
- Body Type

- Email accounts
- Cell phones, smartphones, tablets
- Voice messages to landline phones (home & work)
