

DO I NEED TO SUBMIT PLANS TO THE MENLO PARK FIRE DISTRICT?

Based upon the type of permit you are submitting for and the scope of work, you may need to submit for review with the Menlo Park Fire Protection District to ensure adherence to local Ordinance requirements. The following checklist will aid in making a decision if you need to submit for review with the Menlo Park Fire Protection District.

Ex. Replacement of water heater, new electrical panel, etc-no submittal required
