

**CITY ATTORNEY'S IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS  
OF MEASURE \_\_**

[ Measure \_\_ would amend the East Palo Alto Municipal Code to establish term limits for City Councilmembers.

Currently, the Municipal Code does not limit how long an individual may serve on the City Council. This measure would limit individuals to a maximum of three (3) consecutive four-year terms, or a total of twelve (12) years. A partial term of more than two (2) years would count as a full term.

The limitation would apply only to terms that begin after the ordinance takes effect, which under Elections Code Section 9217, would be in December 2026. Any terms served by an individual on the City Council before that date would not count towards the term limit.

This measure was placed on the ballot by the City Council of the City of East Palo Alto. It requires a majority vote to pass.

Voting "Yes" means adopting these term limits for City Councilmembers.

Voting "No" means City Councilmembers would not be subject to term limits.
