Re: Monthly Flock audit
Date: April 1, 2026

I conducted the March 2026 audit of the Flock System per East Palo Alto Police Department Policy 428. The audit is from March 1 through March 31. The Flock system captured 4,808,919 license plates during this month. During the audit period East Palo Alto Officers conducted 1,465 searches. All of these searches were made within policy with valid cases numbers and/or reasons for the search.

As of today's date, we have all 25 cameras live.

I audited the activity of the agencies that we share our data with and confirmed they are all California agencies and followed the California Values Act (SB 54.)

East Palo Alto Flock cameras notable activity:

- 1) March 7, 2026 – Robbery – A young female victim was robbed of her jewelry at 3:15 PM. Surveillance video was obtained and a suspect vehicle was observed. Detectives used Flock to positively identify the suspect vehicle. Search warrants were executed, which resulted in evidence of other robberies being discovered along with additional suspects. Case is currently under investigation.
- 2) March 13, 2026 – On March 12, a hit and run occurred in East Palo Alto. Officers located a license plate on the suspect vehicle and uploaded it into Flock. On March 13, the vehicle was located and stopped. In plain view there was a loaded firearm. The driver was arrested and denied involvement in the hit and run.
- 3) March 16, 2026 – Carjacking– The victim was robbed at gun point of his vehicle at the 7-11. The vehicle was entered into the stolen vehicle system. The stolen vehicle hit San Jose Flock system and two suspect were arrested by San Jose Police.
- 4) March 17, 2026 – Felony wanted vehicle – East Palo Alto Officers were alerted by Flock of a wanted vehicle from San Jose Police entering the city. Officers canvased the area and located the vehicle occupied. The vehicle stopped and the occupants were identified and released. San Jose Police requested the vehicle impounded, which we did for them.

- 5) March 22, 2026 – Robbery / pursuit – The victim observed several subjects breaking into his work truck. The suspects confronted and assaulted the victim. Officers canvassing the area, located the suspect vehicle, and attempted a traffic stop. The suspect vehicle fled over the Dumbarton bridge at speeds over 120 MPH. The pursuit was terminated for safety concerns. Officers utilized Flock and located the vehicle in Oakland. The vehicle was an unreported stolen vehicle.
- 6) March 24, 2026 – ShotSpotter / firearm possession – East Palo Alto Officers were dispatched to a ShotSpotter in the 1900 Block of Cooley. Arriving Officers determined a shooting had occurred and obtained a suspect vehicle. Additional Officers located a suspect vehicle at the Chevron Gas Station. The occupants were contacted and two illegal firearms were located. Officers utilized Flock to show that this vehicle was on the West Side of East Palo Alto during the shooting. Two suspects were booked into jail.
- 7) March 25, 2026 – Stolen vehicle – East Palo Alto Officers were dispatched to a stolen vehicle report, which had just occurred. Officers entered the vehicle into Flock and located it at University and Bay Road. The driver led Officers on a short pursuit, when the suspect fled the vehicle. The suspect was apprehended and booked into Jail.
- 8) March 29, 2026 – A traffic stop was attempted, but the driver failed to yield. The Officer decided not to pursue the vehicle. The Officer utilized Flock and his in-car camera to locate a license plate. The Officer wrote a seizure warrant for the suspect vehicle for the pursuit. The vehicle was located the next day in Mountain View, and seized pursuant to the warrant. The registered owner came to the Police Department and confessed to the crime.
- 9) March 31, 2026 – Stolen vehicle – East Palo Alto Officers were alerted to a stolen motorcycle entering the city from Flock. Officers located the occupied motorcycle and took the suspect into custody without incident. The suspect was booked into jail.
