Re: Monthly Flock audit

I conducted the May 2026 audit of the Flock System per East Palo Alto Police Department Policy 428. The audit is from May 1 through May 31. The Flock system captured 3,172,413 license plates during this month. During the audit period East Palo Alto Officers conducted 768 searches. All of these searches were made within policy with valid cases numbers and/or reasons for the search.

As of today's date, we have all 25 cameras live, and the additional 5 cameras in our the permitting stage.

I audited the activity of the agencies that we share our data with and confirmed they are all California agencies and followed the California Values Act (SB 54)





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East Palo Alto Flock cameras notable activity:

- 1) May 5, 2026 - Grand theft PGA store – East Palo Alto Officers were dispatched a grand theft of golf clubs that had just occurred. Officers were able to obtain a license plate for the suspect vehicle. Officers utilized Flock to positively place the suspect vehicle in East Palo Alto during the theft. Officers entered the vehicle into the State database for a felony wanted vehicle. On May 7, the San Jose Police Department received a Flock alert of this wanted vehicle. San Jose Police were able to locate the vehicle occupied. The driver was positively identified as our suspect and arrested.
- 2) May 9, 2026 – Attempt murder – East Palo Alto Officers were dispatched to a ShotSpotter shooting that had just occurred. Officers arrived on scene and obtained the description of two suspect vehicles that had fled the scene after the shooting. Officers utilized Flock to locate license plates on both vehicles. One of the vehicles was located in East Palo Alto, and both occupants sustained gun shot wounds. Both were transported to Stanford Hospital in stable condition. The second vehicle had fled East Palo Alto. Flock was utilized to track the vehicles movements into San Joaquin County. A San Joaquin Deputy located the vehicle occupied. The driver was detained and a firearm recovered. The suspect was arrested and booked into San Mateo County Jail.
- 3) May 15, 2026 – Stolen vehicle recovered – East Palo Alto Officers were notified by Flock of a stolen vehicle entering the city. The vehicle was located and the driver arrested for possession a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was returned to its owner.
