The data collection area is citywide.

Approximately 250k

- 4. Are there any areas that should be excluded in the citywide data collection?** The ordinance is only applicable to residential areas; however, investigation of other areas may be necessary to determine impacts of various restrictions.

What parking-related datasets (occupancy, citations, complaints, permit records, etc.) are available to the selected consultant?** The Police Department may be able to provide citation/ complaint data; however, they would need to confirm. The City's mobility study investigated the Gardens neighborhood in 2020, so some occupancy data is available there.
- 6. Although this is a residential-focused parking project, would data also include commercial districts and other land-uses, especially those adjacent to residential parking?** Same answer as question #4.
