
Tap Water Quality Study

- Nuestra Casa tap water quality study
- "Perception" of water quality not being good in EPA
- "Over half of EPA residents don't feel safe drinking their tap water"
- 715 surveys conducted City wide (City Population 29,593)
- Survey sample size is 2.4% of the City population



City of East Palo Alto Water System -Facts

- City has three water purveyors
- City receives its water from the Hetch Hetchy system
- No violations of water quality
- All of the City's water quality data is posted on the State website






Ensuring safety around East Palo Alto's Water System

- Three Water Receiving Stations throughout the City
- Water Quality checked daily
- Citywide sampling stations checked weekly
- Transparency
 - Monthly reporting to the State
 - Annual Consumer Confidence Reports
- No water quality violations
- Addressing public's concerns
- 365/24/7 Customer Service
