# 2010 Urban Water Management Plan and Water Master Plan

- Water supplies are not adequate
- Groundwater development is a practical alternative

#### 2012 Groundwater Feasibility Study

- Develop a groundwater management plan
- ➤ Initiate monitoring of groundwater levels + quality
- Reactivate Gloria Way Well
- Proceed with groundwater exploration




## Groundwater Management Planning

- Water Code 10753.5 permits groundwater management
- City of East Palo Alto is an authorized local water agency
- Overlies part of the San Mateo Plain Subbasin (No. 2-9.03)
- Initiated GWMP process on October 21, 2014




#### A Public Process

### Basin Management Objectives

- 1. Maintain acceptable groundwater levels
- 2. Avoid subsidence
- 3. Protect groundwater quality
- 4. Integrate groundwater/surface water management
- 5. Improve understanding of groundwater system
- 6. Promote regional management


