The landlord or the tenant of a rental unit may petition to object to the Maximum Allowable Rent (MAR). <u>These petitions must be received within 30 days after certificates of MAR are issued</u> , <u>unless there is good cause for lateness</u> , or fraud or misrepresentation is involved. Tenants may also petition for a hearing to object to excessive rent charges and to seek a rent adjustment and refund to conform to the Maximum Allowable Rent determined under the City of East Palo Alto's Rent Stabilization Ordinance.
